Musical Musing... Thine Be the Glory

This is an Easter hymn written by Swiss writer, Edmond Bundry. The tune was composed in 1747 by Handel for use in his oratorio, *Joshua*, but the tune was so popular that he added it to his oratorio, *Judas Maccabeus* as "See the Conquering Hero Comes". In 1796, Beethoven composed 12 variations on the tune for piano and cello.

This is a popular Easter hymn of the British royal family. It was sung at the service of thanksgiving for Queen Elizabeth's 80th birthday. During the Last Night of the Proms in the U.K., this hymn is played after "Fantasia on British Sea Songs" with the audience traditionally whistling the tune.
